

HEARING THE VOICE OF GOD

Instructions: Write down anything you feel God is saying to you, or ask God to speak to you about this question: **What do you think of me?** Write below what you think you hear the Lord saying to you by His Holy Spirit.

Don't freak out if you hear Him, because we believe you will. If you don't, no worries, just try this exercise again another time when you are relaxed and quiet in His presence.

Again, any time you listen for the Lord's voice, it's always good to check what you receive by the Word of God or through someone who is well versed in the Word of God.

The Holy Spirit will only communicate what is consistent with God's Word. His role is to teach us and remind us of the things that Jesus said. So God's written Word will not change.

Conversation with God is like talking to a friend. If you are His sheep, then He promises that you will know His voice. He may give you Scripture or say something "scriptural," meaning in context with His character and the Scriptures. Again, when in doubt, run it by someone you trust for confirmation. That is one of the wonderful benefits of godly mentors in your life.

"My sheep hear my voice, and I know them, and they follow me." (John 10:27)

"But they will never follow a stranger; in fact, they will run away from him because they do not recognize a stranger's voice." (John 10:5)
